UC Priorities for Asset Selection





- CEF 2015: Assets to be maintained and prepared by EXPAND for hand over to CEF
 - ❖ Patient summary, chronic diseases, continuity of care
 - E-Prescription
 - Patient Registries
 - Reference Networks
- WIDER CROSS BORDER USE CASES: Assets to be assessed and signposted as future extensions of CEF priorities.
 - ❖ Medical imaging information sharing
 - ❖ Hospital diagnostic imaging workflow
 - Laboratory information sharing
 - Hospital laboratory workflow
 - ❖ Tele-monitoring of chronic diseases (hospital / home), telemedicine services
 - ❖ Integrated neonatal care
 - Well-being management information shared within EHRs





- Consolidation is needed
- Support CEF subgroup of MS concerning the identification and prioritization of a use cases and a roadmap for their implementation in CEF (and beyond)







Business modeling

- ✓ limited to the two CEF eHealth priorities for 2015
- ✓ short term sustainability through CEF funding and national level investment,
 - Existing assets (incl. Antilope assets)
 - Adoption status of each asset
 - Core and generic services
 - Assets utilization







- ✓ List of Assets for CEF 2015
- ✓ Providing clarity in support of preparation of calls
 - described the eHealth business use case for CEF 2015 priorities
 - described the "infrastructure" to support the business use cases
- ✓ a pilot version of the asset register







- Support the process of hand over to CEF including through supporting the CEF procurements e.g. by adding clarity to needed key documentation inherited by epSOS
- Handover to Value Health to continue with the business modeling and sustainability models beyond CEF.


