- Support for Patient Centric pathways of care using technology as a unifying force
- Data providing Information and Knowledge which must be recorded and shared
- Focus on social care and community services
- Greater integration of services

Challenges

Shift towards locally held and controlled records brings a number of challenges...

- Information Consistency
 - Locating Information
 - Retrieving Information
 - Managing Changes
 - Knowing when things change

Data Standards

HSCIC deliver Data Standards

- HL7v2 and HL7v3 (MIM), and HL7v3 CDA
 - HL7 UK board membership
 - HL7 FHIR working groups
 - RCP Standards Adoption - CDGRS
-

Local Interoperable Solutions

- Interoperability Toolkit (ITK) launched in 2010
 - XML, HL7, Web Services,
 - National Specifications using HL7 at the heart
 - Focused on the push pattern
 - Mapping to Antelope ALT Model:
 - Technical Level (explicit), Logical Level (partly), Application level (guidance)
 - ITK Accreditation forms part of the offering

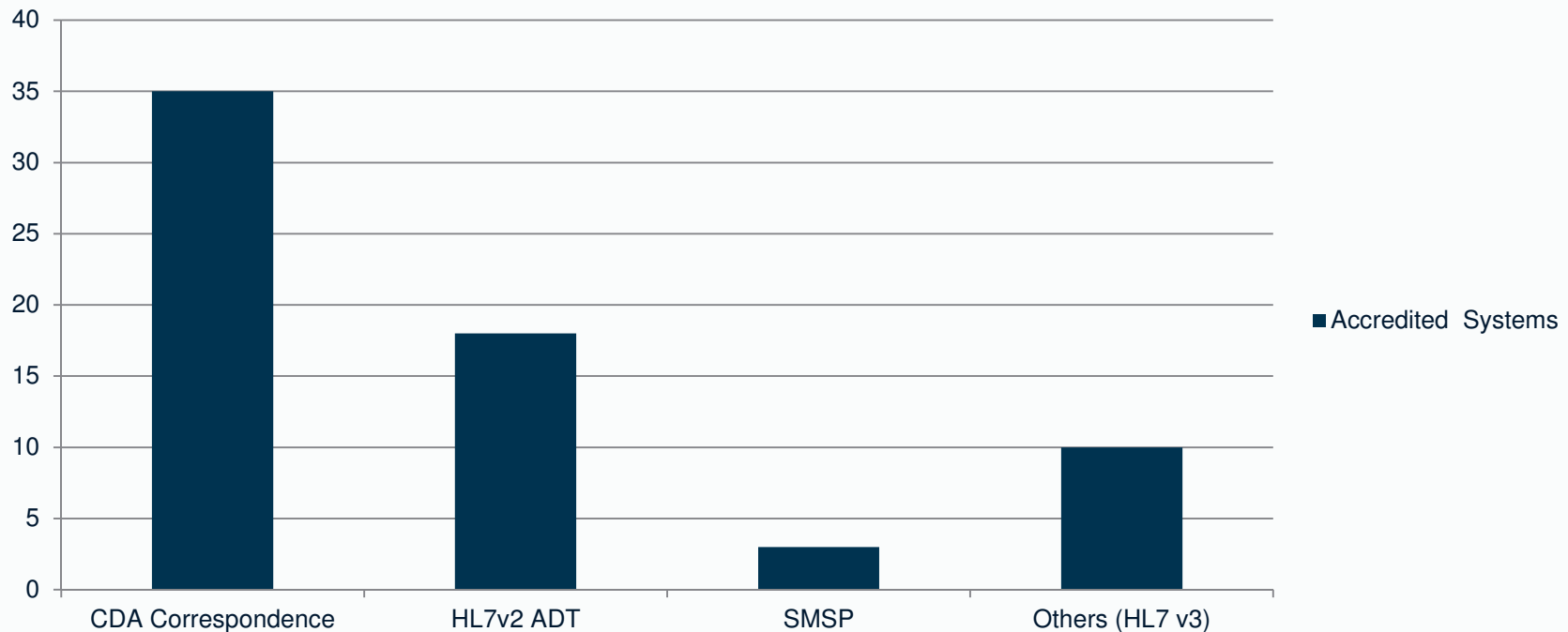
ITK Accreditation - Test Tooling

- Testing tool – ITK Toolkit Workbench (TKW) which is open source
 - Supplier selects Profile and Transport
 - e.g. Discharge Summary over Web Services
 - Automated test suite based around prescribed test plan
 - Generates evidence of technical conformance

ITK Accreditation

- Service provided by HSCIC
- Over 60 accredited systems

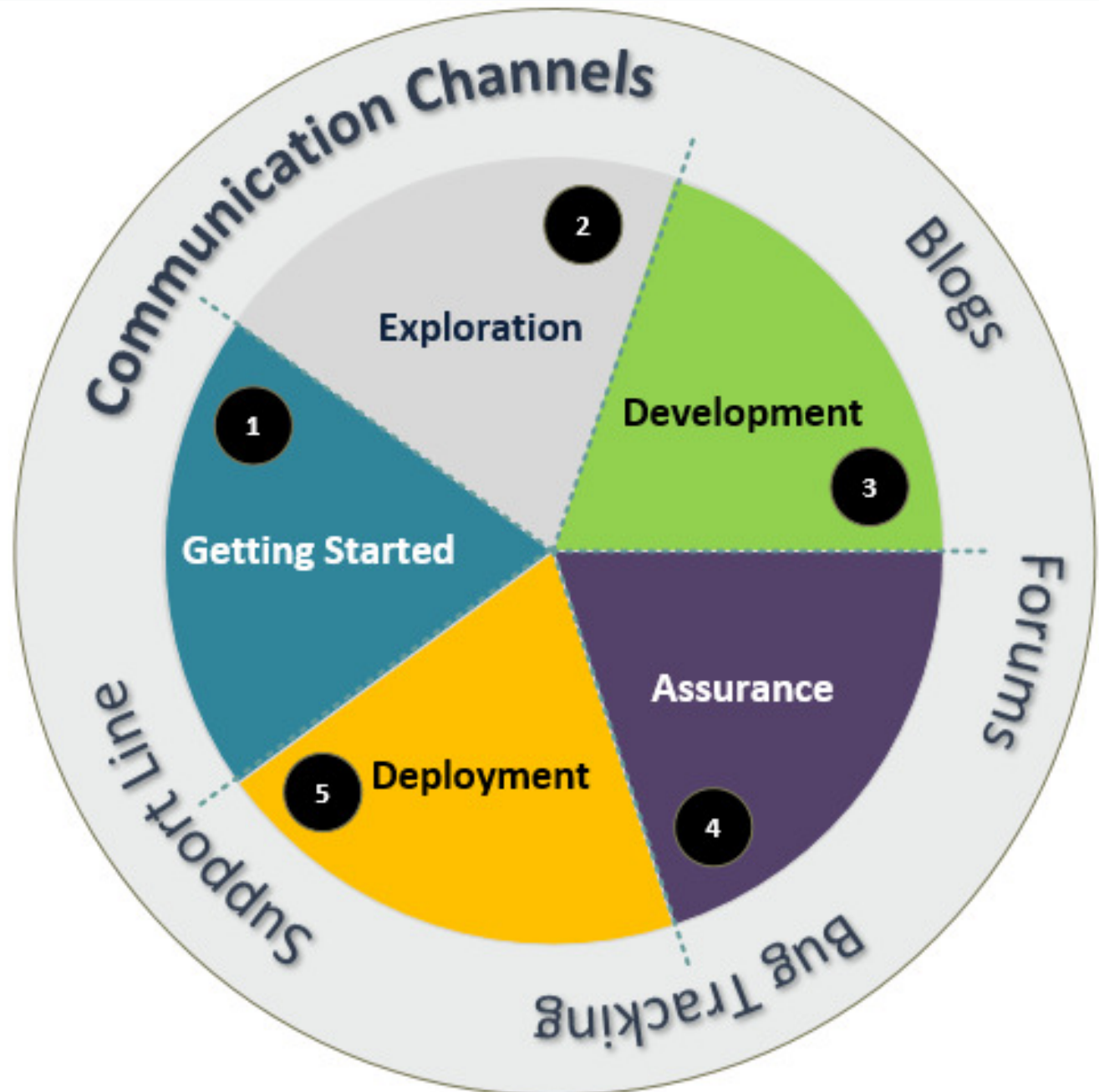

Changing Face of Assurance

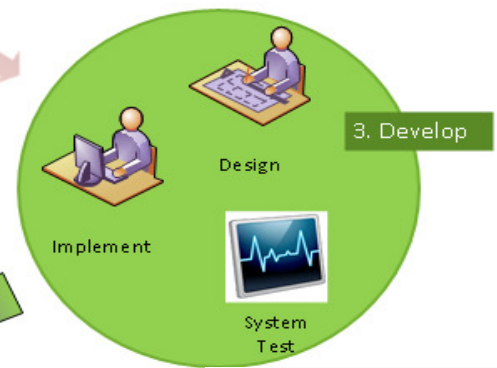
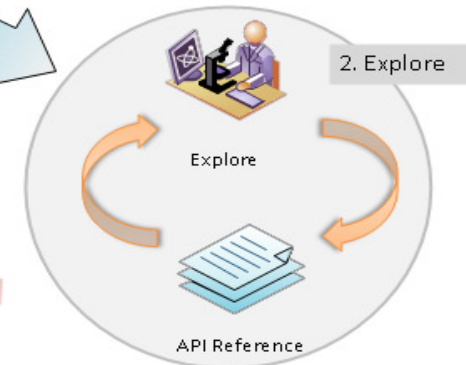
- The NHS e-Referral System (e-RS) will replace Choose and Book this year

NHS e-RS Ecosystem Components

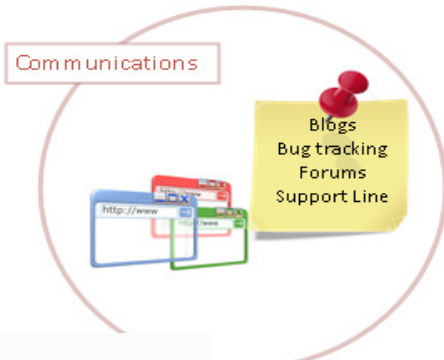
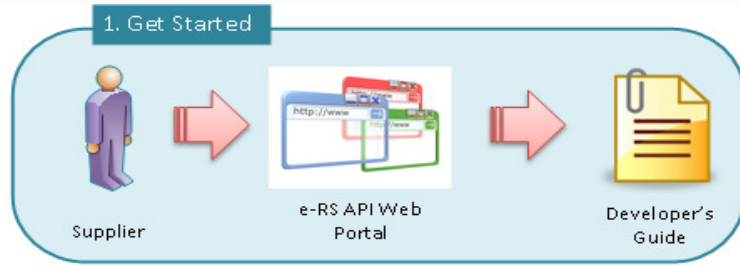


NHS e-RS API Ecosystem – Journey

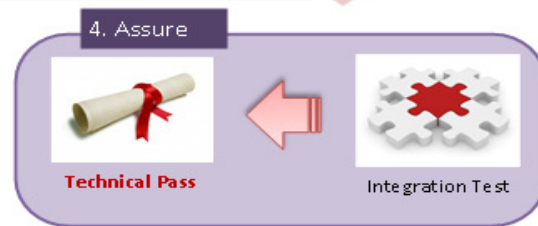
