- **Political level**
  - The eHealth Network (eHN) should take note of the Antilope results because it offers interoperability tools for countries wanting to deploy interoperability
  - The eHN should make a proposal to the Connecting Europe Facility to standardise cross border medical exchanges based on the Antilope results.
- **Operational level**
  - Provide contribution and support to the national/regional level for adoption of Antilope Framework
  - Define an implementation policy driven governance: Cross-European Collaboration platform on eHealth interoperability



Antilope results are not perfect! Work is in progress.  
You should build on Antilope rather than re-inventing the wheel.

- **Main recommendations:**

- Establish a collaboration platform on eHealth Interoperability
- Need better collaboration on EU projects
- Define and maintain the assets:
  - eHealth European Interoperability Framework
  - Test methods (new tools and improvement)
- Define the European Conformity Assessment scheme
- Support countries/regions to use Antilope results for local adaptation (guidelines, education,....)
- Maintain the networks that were engaged in Antilope
